

**East Prospect Borough Council Meeting
Community Hall, East Prospect, PA
February 4, 2026 @ 6:00 p.m.**

On Wednesday, February 4, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. the East Prospect Borough Council was called to order by President Don Barshinger, and opened with the pledge to the American flag.

Present: Don Barshinger, Mick Regel, George Dvorak, Victor Dodson, and Shawn Keller.
Others in attendance: Mayor David Bubb, Secretary Mindy Barshinger, Atty. David Jones, and Engineer David Lipinski. Absent: Treasurer Marian Hunter.

Minutes of the January 7, 2026 meeting were approved as read.

Payment of bills: Motion by Victor Dodson, seconded by Shawn Keller, to approve and pay the general account bills and accept the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Patrons: Kathy & Kurvin Schrum, Tina Paduhovich, (only to observe), Chief Thomas (LWTPD), and EYCEMA Coordinator Chris Eaton.

Chris Eaton mentioned several items to be concerned about when the Rt 462 bridge is closed down for repairs.....people will have to go to Harrisburg or Holtwood to get across the bridge.....he also said that the bridge repair is a Lancaster County project. Chris also commented on several changes to the 2026 EYCEMA operations plan. (all Council members were emailed a copy). Don Barshinger made a motion, seconded by Victor Dodson, to approve the 2026 Eastern York County Emergency Operations Plan. Motion carried.

Chief Thomas passed out the December/January incident reports. He also passed out the year-end 2025 report.

Atty. Jones told Council that in 2013, the Borough entered into an agreement with Lower Windsor Township that they would maintain/plow snow on Livia Lane/East Maple Street (the portion that is in the Borough). In response, Lower Windsor Township was to send the Borough invoices for the work done on Livia Lane, which were never received. In the agreement, it states that Lower Windsor Township was to receive liquid fuel money for the work done on Livia Lane/East Maple Street. The last time LWT received money, from the Borough was in 2013; therefore, 2014-2025 reimbursement to LWT is to be paid. Atty. Jones is working on the numbers.

A possible agreement, with LWT, could be entered into for LWT to plow snow on Stoneheath Lane and Hedgewick Lane.

A phone call, was received, from a USAA insurance representative, inquiring as to when the property at 45 West Maple Street (George Harman) was condemned. USSA represents the people who purchased 47 West Maple Street. Atty. Jones said that the house at 45 West Maple Street was never condemned. Mindy will give Atty. Jones the insurance gentleman's name and phone number to contact.

Engineer Dave Lipinski reported that he submitted the application for the state-wide grant January 30th....Council will not find out if we get the grant until September 2026.

Nothing new happening with Magnolia Meadows; still waiting on HOP permits. The last revision for the permit was submitted January 29th.

Mayor's Report -- received complaints about the snow plowing

Old Business: suggestions for 250th anniversary celebration -- Don will set up a committee with residents/council members to discuss how and what kind of celebration to have.

New thermostats installed in gym area? Yes- job completed

Report of Committees:

Hall Committee -- February 28th -- Craley FC turkey supper -- Lions Club supper (3) weeks later. Don thanked George Dvorak and Victor Dodson for installing the new thermostats. Discussion was also held on insulating the ceiling in the gym area... George D. volunteered to look into the cost.

Street Committee -- speed sign info passed out.....new hoses put on plow....company who fixed the truck said that drivers should be careful not to overload with cinders.....also be careful going over manholes. Shawn K. replaced the street sign that was broke off....

Parks & Recreation Committee -- the 2025 year-end financial report was passed out

Ordinance Committee -- nothing

Human Resource's Committee -- Marian had a question about payment for Amanda Wompler.. When she was setting up the web -page, she was paid \$ 40.00 per hour.....now that the web-page is up and running, she receives \$ 50.00 a month for maintaining it.

Other Business -- Victor Dodson made a motion, seconded by Mick Regel, to get Al Vican a \$100 gift card to Longhorn Steak House for clearing the snow off the walking path. Motion carried.
